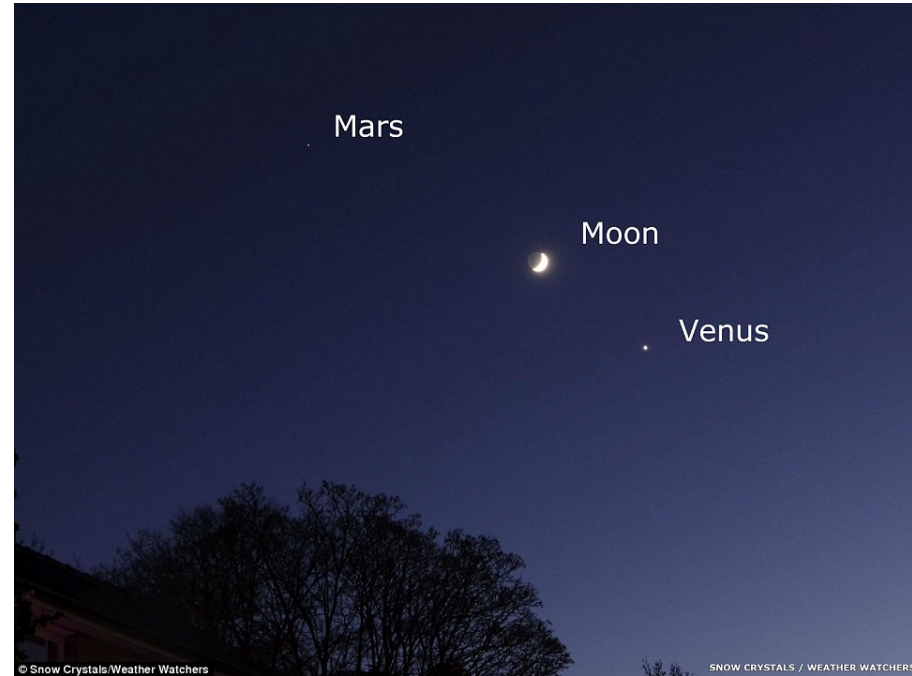

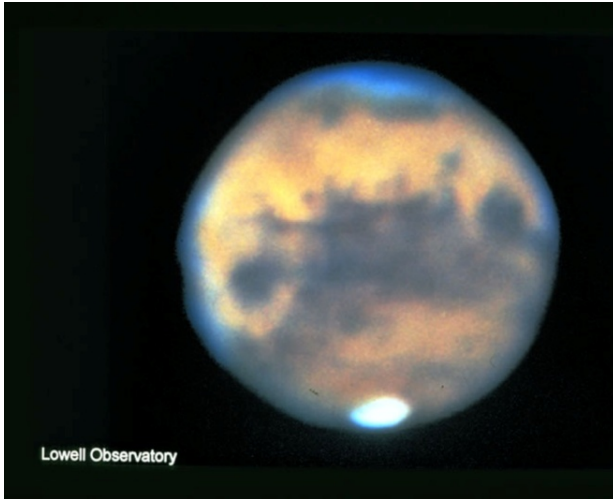
Saturn in Leo



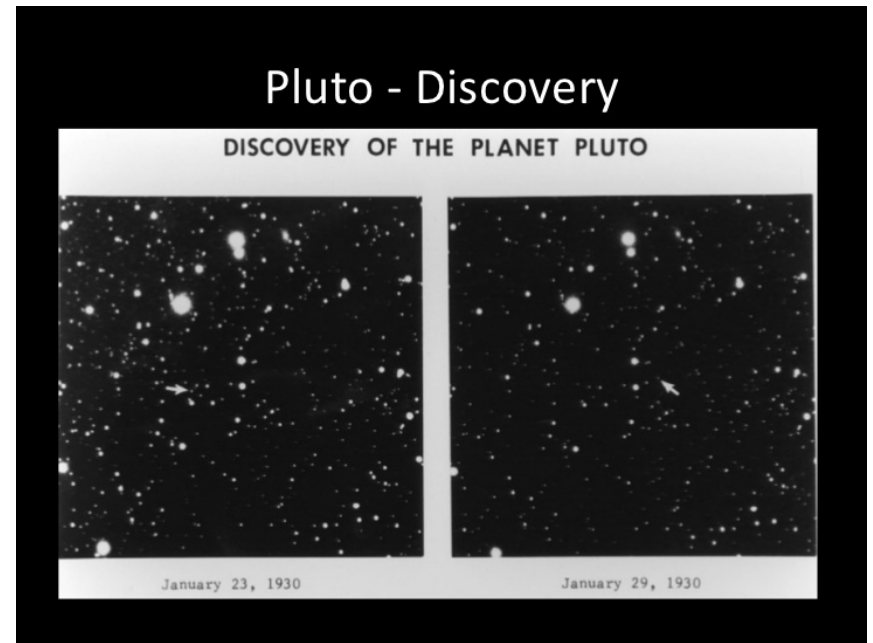
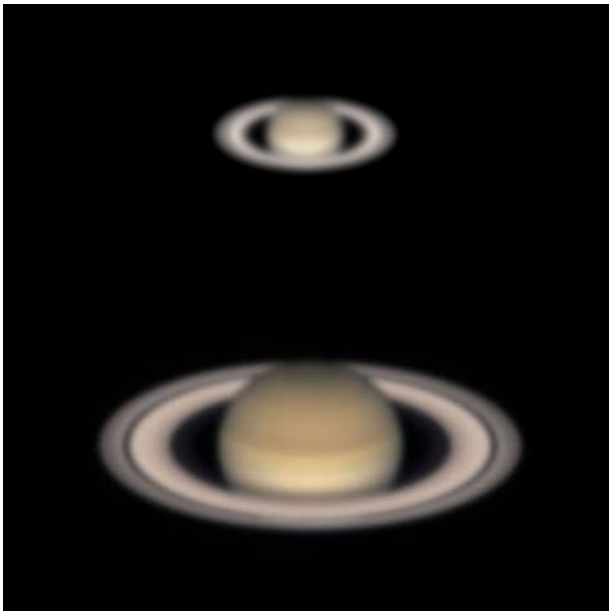
Mars and Venus with the Moon

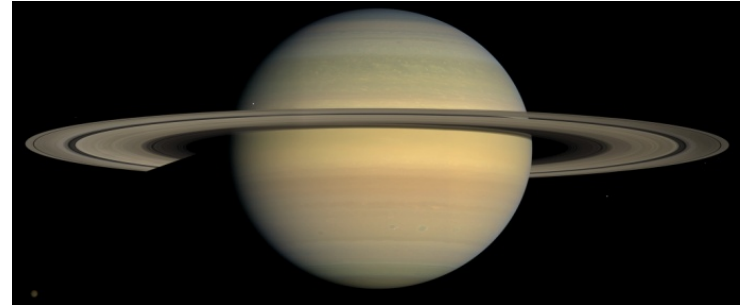


Discovery of Pluto
